Legislative Issues/ Accomplishments



GROWING PA'S HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION MARKET

Our goal is to create a political environment in which policymakers pass legislation to move PennDOT's annual letting program from \$2.9 billion in 2025 to \$3.5 billion over the next two years. This goal is not out of the realm of possibility. This year represents a unique opportunity to pursue a highway funding increase as part of this year's state fiscal budget. With your support, the TCI-PAC provided strategic support to candidates, many of whom are in leadership positions, helping keep open the lines of communication to make such legislation possible.



CONTINUING TO STOP THE DIVERSION OF HIGHWAY FUNDS

One of the major drains on the state highway fund has been continuous transfers to the Pennsylvania State Police for its general operations. While the diversions are finally being reduced from an all-time high of \$802 million annually, they continue. TCI-PAC successfully reduced this figure down to \$250 million, where it sits today. TCI-PAC is working to resume this phase-down and reduce the overall level to zero over the next few years. TCI-PAC will continue to work with Governor Shapiro and the General Assembly to ensure that Motor License Funds are being used as intended – to improve the condition of our state's roads and bridges.



SECURING SHORT-TERM FUNDING FOR INDUSTRY NEEDS

The Senate Transportation Committee introduced legislation to provide for a \$600 million short-term bonding program for bridges on state three- and four-digit roadways that are not part of the National Highway System. If enacted, PennDOT would use savings from the additional debt to improve highways on the same three- and four-digit road network statewide. TCI-PAC will aggressively push for this legislation to pass the General Assembly in 2026 and could be coupled with the FY2026-27 budget to provide a dedicated revenue source to pay for bond debt service.
